







FY 2008-2013












#### FY 2013 Sponsored Programs Direct Costs by Major Source

#### FY 2013 Resident Instruction and Other Units Direct Costs





#### FY 2013 College of Sciences Direct Costs



#### FY 2013 College of Engineering Direct Costs






#### FY 2013 Resident Instruction and Other Units F&A Costs TOTAL \$75,942,000

FY 2013 College of Computing F&A Costs



#### FY 2013 College of Sciences F&A Costs



#### FY 2013 College of Engineering F&A Costs


